TASTING NOTES

Son of a Bull is the brainchild of a bull at a gate – it's fresh, frisky and impulsive. These 'live for the moment' Tasmanian wines are for drinking at a young age – no cellaring required.



Pipers River Sauvignon Blanc 2018

Picked in the cool of night and packaged early, locking in the fresh gooseberry and passionfruit aromas. A refreshing, dry wine with crunchy acidity.

Pipers River Riesling 2018

Picked late after extra time on the north slopes. An aromatic wine with citrus blossom and spice. The palate is supple with perfectly harmonised sugars and acidity.

Pipers River Gewürztraminer 2018

Gewürtz [gur-vertz] is German for spice. True to its name, this Gewürztraminer has the aromas of spice, lychee and rose water. Off-dry, delicate and finely balanced, this wine pairs well with spicy cuisine.

Pipers River Pinot Noir 2018

This wine spent a neat and tidy seven days on skins, resulting in a bright red wine full of plum, cherry and spice with a dash of French oak.
