About Rosé

Rosé is an all occasion wine full of freshness, brightness, crispness, and lightness.

Proper Rosé is made from the gentle and short extraction of juice from red grape varieties to obtain only the lightest tinges of pinks from the grape skins. After this extraction, rosé is largely made in the same way as white wine.

Many, even most, red grape varieties or blends thereof are suitable for making rosé. Different varieties give different flavours and colours and there is an “official” colour coding that refers to the flesh of fruits including: cantelope, peach, red currant, ruby grapefruit, mango and mandarin.

Tasting Notes

Pale rose gold in colour with a subtle, shy nose - a bouquet of Pink Lady apples and raspberry confection. The plush palate is brimming with strawberries and cream, red liquorice, musk and has a refreshing citrus edge. A clean, fresh, modern style with a balanced acidity and a crisp, dry finish. Enjoy now and over the next 2 years.

The 2019 Season

The 2018 growing season ended with a wet winter, followed by a mild spring that opened 2019 vintage. In Western Australia the summer was atypical, remaining mild throughout. These cooler conditions dictated a later start to the harvest but allowed for a gradual and measured ripening of grapes.

The moderate conditions continued through autumn as the reds were harvested in April. The 2019 red wines show a concentration of flavour, elegance, definition and supple tannins, which are a signature of the slightly cooler years.

When to Drink and With What

Enjoy now or over the next 2 years with shared plates of chargrilled octopus, Parmesan & pumpkin arancini, grilled chorizo, Jamon Iberico and crusty bread.
